The PBCCG logo was created especially for our organization by Ivonne Zegveld under the direction of Winthrop Curiel. They started with the existing PBC (NL) carnation which has been a symbol of the work our foundations support for quite some decades. Out of that carnation we can see pollens flying out into many directions, symbolizing an explosion of seeds of arts, culture and creativity which together we spread and sow. Also, exploding from the flower are six distinct circles representing our six Dutch Caribbean islands upon which the seeds are sown.

Formats

Our logo is designed in blue, orange and black. The logo is also made available in a gray scale and in reverse color to be used on dark backgrounds. Choose your option based on your particular needs.

Safety space

Usage guidelines

Don't:

- Use speech bubbles or words around the logo
- Rotate or change the direction of the logo
- Animate the logo
- Change the color of the logo
- Overprint or obstruct any part of the logo
- Add special effects to the logo
- Use old versions or any other marks or logos to represent us

Don't:

- Display the PBCCG logo or trademarks larger than your own marks.
- Use the PBCCG marks to refer to any other than PBCCG itself.
